Instruction Page for Edmodo



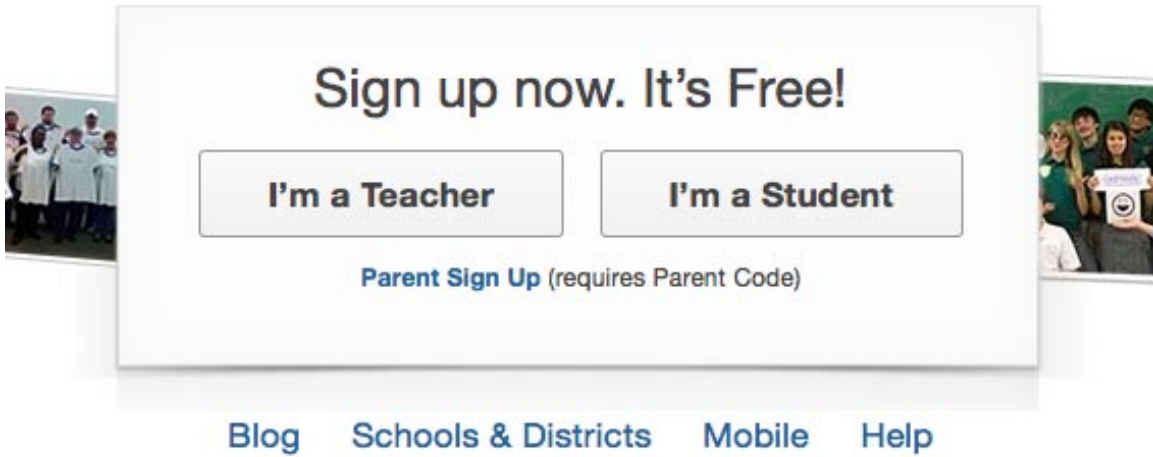
Edmodo Provides a safe and easy way for your class to connect and collaborate, share content, and access homework, grades and school notices. Edmodo's goal is to help educators harness the power of social media to customize the classroom for each and every learner. There are four simple steps to get you started.

1. Create a Teacher Account

- a. Go to <http://www.edmodo.com/>



b. Click on "I'm a Teacher."



c. Complete the required information.


d. Click "Sign up"

2. Create a Group

- a. Click on "Create" along the left side of the screen in the "Groups" section.

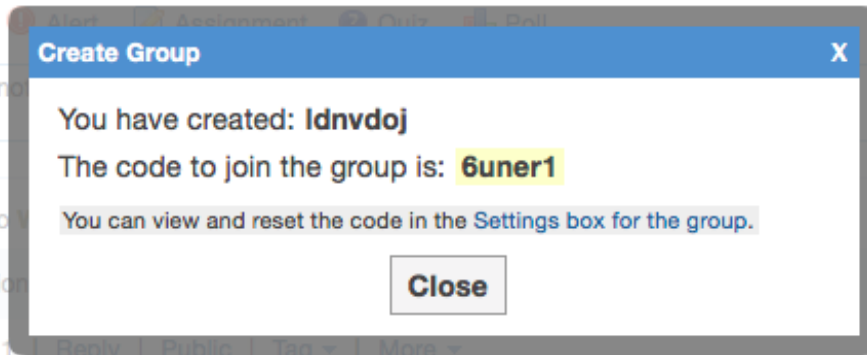


- b. Complete the information box by creating a group name, grade, and subject area.

- c. Click "Create" at the bottom of the box.

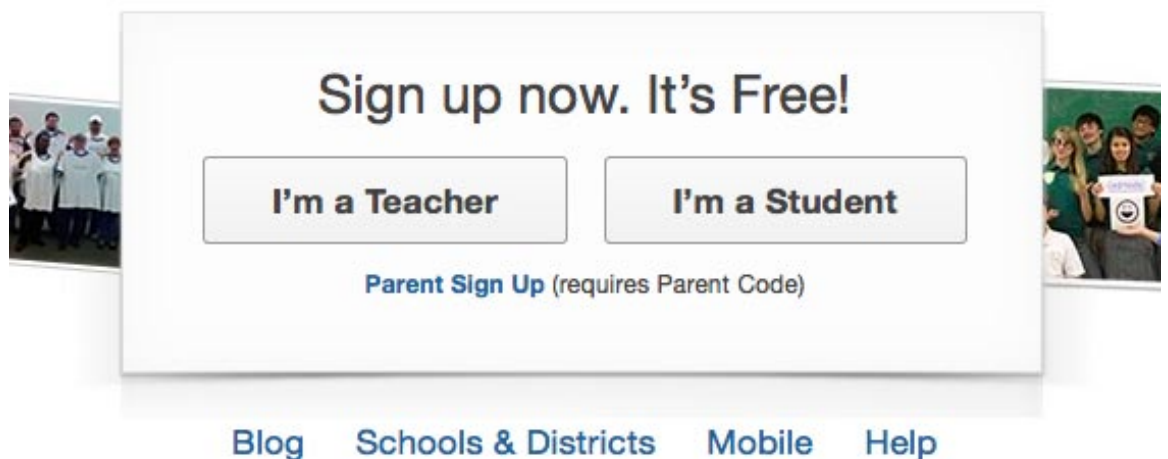
d. Write down the "Group Code" for future use.



e. Click "Close."


3. Share your group code with your students.

- a. Post your group code in your classroom or in the computer lab.
- b. Have students go to the Edmodo home page and click on "I'm a Student."



- c. Students should enter the group code for your class, a user name, and password they will easily

remember. Do NOT have them enter an email address. Then have them complete the name section.



- d. Students then click "Sign up."
This will allow students to join your group or class so you can send them messages, links, surveys, videos, and pictures.

4. Send your group (class) a message.

- a. login to Edmodo
- b. Along the top of the screen you'll see a place to type a note to your group (class).
